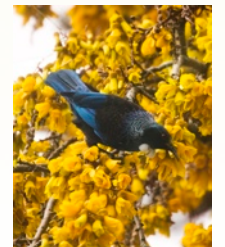

Many visitors to the South Island are amazed at the contrast between the east and west coasts. On the West coast you will see glaciers as they plunge through beautiful rainforest, and experience the sheer power of the Tasman Sea as it crashes into the broad bays and rocky headlands. Towering snow fed peaks reflect in mirror like lakes, fishermen drag their nets to catch the elusive whitebait a local delicacy, and this is the home of the rare white heron. "Coasters" are proud people descended from the pioneer gold miners of the 1800's. We are treated to a visit to an old friend, Andris Apse, considered one of the World's finest landscape photographers. His gallery is open by invitation only.

As we cross the Haast pass into The Central Otago Lakes district, the contrast is noticeable. Gone is the bush, the lush green, and in its place are blue lakes, golden tussock plains, vineyards and this is our home base for three days. Queenstown deservedly enjoys an international reputation for stunning vistas of beautiful lakes and mountains. We are entering 'Lord of the Rings' country where you will enjoy the thrill of jet boating the Dart River.

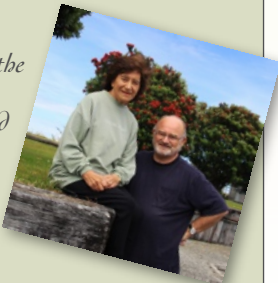
To visit the South Island there is an absolute must, and this is Milford Sound. We overnight
